



Supplemental Kindergarten Program

At **Kids 'R' Kids** we work with the district kindergarten curriculum to offer a continuum of learning. Whether your child attends morning or afternoon kindergarten, we open at 6:30 AM and offer breakfast from 7:30 AM – 8:00 AM.

The PM kindergartners spend their morning in our class Learning Centers (arts & crafts, books and writing, dramatic play and home living, math & blocks, music & movement, science and cooking). They also have outdoor play, morning snack, and story and circle time.

Kids 'R' Kids also offers computer time so kindergartners have an opportunity on a daily basis to acquire and practice computer skills.

Afternoon kindergartners have a healthy lunch before boarding the bus for school. The arriving AM kindergartners have their lunch and then quiet or naptime. The rest of the day is spent in the learning centers, and joining their PM kindergarten friends for afternoon snack and outdoor play. The very end of the day offers small group activities.

The kindergartners use the "School Age" playground with age appropriate equipment. This, plus other organized outdoor activities, aids in expanding your child's gross motor skills while classroom skills like cutting and writing develop small motor skills.

In addition to the many social skills the children acquire, they also gain reading and math readiness. They have opportunities through the day to work and play in both large and small groups.

You are provided a daily written report of your child's activities, meals, general behavior and accomplishments. We encourage parents to reinforce the learning experiences provided at **Kids 'R' Kids**.
